Dear Mr. Davies:

On July 5, 2007, you filed a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, OS-2007-00535, stating:

“I would like to break out part of my previous request, referenced above, and to which you responded on June 27.

Incorporating all the relevant statutory and regulatory references of my previous request, I would like to find out whether former DAS-FWP Julie MacDonald received an award in 2007 -- cash, time-off or otherwise.

If yes, I request any justification documents or other documentation, e.g., from the federal personnel/payroll system.”

On July 6, 2007, we acknowledged your request, advised you of your fee status as a “media-use” requester, and stated that we had initiated file searches for responsive records within the Minerals Management Human Resources office, the Secretary’s Immediate Office, the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Fish Wildlife and Parks, and the Payroll Operations Division, National Business Center, Denver.

We are writing to you today to provide you with the results of our file searches.

Enclosed, in response to the first part of your request, is one (1) document consisting of a total of one (1) page being released to you in full.

The second part of your request asks for “any justification documents or other documentation, e.g., from the federal personnel/payroll system.” We have found no records responsive to this part of your request.

FOIA Fees Incurred:

The FOIA fee for the processing of your request is \$72.53, calculated as follows:


2 hours Professional Search Time	@ \$9.05 per ¼ hour
